

Applying for a PhD position with ACELG

The Amsterdam Centre for European Law and Governance invites applications for Ph.D. research projects that fall within the scope of the following research clusters:

The European Economic Constitution

The regulatory framework of economic market processes has always been the core pillar of European integration and formed the basis of the constitutional order in Europe. Under the heading of the European Economic Constitution, ACELG conducts research on governance design for competition law and policy in Europe, on the role of individual market actors in the regulatory field and on the effectiveness of regulatory policies in specific sectors.

Candidates are invited to develop proposals on the role and position of individuals on the market such as the citizens and consumers in the recently adopted 'Europe 2020 Strategy' and the role of consumers in regulated sectors, with a specific focus on the energy sector (project in cooperation with the Amsterdam Centre for Energy).

Furthermore, ACELG is interested in proposals on the institutional embedding of competition law enforcement, in research proposals that critically evaluate the legal infrastructure of markets and in proposals that compare and evaluate the use of EU legal infrastructures as blueprint in other multi-level governance systems. Finally candidates are invited to develop proposals on the application of EU competition law to the education sector.

General information

Suggestions for PhD projects in any specific field of law or on any specific thematic issue, *related to the above themes*, are also welcome. Proposals would preferably consist of legal textual analysis and empirical research. Please also indicate how the suggested research relates to the ACELG research programme on 'Compound Constitution(s) in Europe' (available for download below).
